We have more children taking part in out of school sport activities that are teacher led and know that many have joined external out of school clubs as a result of having experience of this within school (gymnastics has seen a big increase). We also have a reduced number of children who are absent on PE days or unable to take part in a PE lesson due to them being inclusive and children feeling that they can achieve.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	Children are much more active during the school day at break, lunch and daily mile and many of them now stay for after school sporting clubs.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	We have taken an increasing number to sporting events this year and often putting in more than one team and join with other local small schools to field 3 teams between the two schools where we have had too many for one team but not enough for two teams.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	We have closely monitored which children are attending extra-curricular activities and speak to those that are not to see what they would join the following term so that we can adapt our provision to reach the widest range of children.
How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?	This year we have developed further our CPD of using our PE scheme by having an additional teacher who works for them to co-teach all elements so that all staff including the ECT feel confident to deliver this going forward and to make the maximum use of it.

All staff have been enabled to take school teams to external events and sports competitions, this has been done through careful planning and covering of classes so that children see that all teachers are teachers of PE.
How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?	All of our Y6 pupils were able to complete their NC requirements this year and the extended offer to all other year groups meant that swimming was improved by all. This is vital as the school is based within a water park
How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?	We have ensured that outside of the PE lessons as well as during swimming lessons children are taught about water safety. The school took part in drowning prevention week too.
