

#### A New School Year

I am delighted to welcome the new families and pupils to the school as well as those returning. We have a record breaking 58 children on roll! This is great news for us as we will need to increase our numbers in order to see our dream of not only having a purpose built third classroom but the interest to start a pre-school. Although the school has operated with three classes since just before I joined, we are still regarded by the local authority as a two class school. The rise in numbers will continue to be a "chicken and egg" situation where we do not get the funding for the additional children until the financial year after they join. I want to reassure you that all decisions regarding the school are made with the children front and centre and to balance the books for this growth I have once again increased my teaching commitment, and increased teaching assistant hours so our adult to child ratio remains excellent.

#### Communications between home and school

If your child is absent from school, please complete the online form via parentmail, email or phone the school. If your child is being collected by somebody else, please phone or email both Mrs Woodruffe and I to ensure we pick this up by the end of the school day. These are not monitored daily but are checked a couple of times a week by either myself or the class teachers. Our first set of parents' evenings this year are the week of 9th October.
