

# Year of reading

We are delighted that as part of our commitment to promote reading for pleasure throughout the school and ensuring that all children see themselves as readers, we launched the graphic novel club this week. Lisa from Cirencester Library came into school to launch it and brought a variety of books with her, she also runs a weekly session that is open to all children at Cirencester Library on a Tuesday at 4pm.

Through our Year of Reading project, we have been granted tickets again this autumn for several Stroud book festival events. Children in Year 1 and 2 will be travelling to Stroud to see James Carter author of Bears, Bugs and Beasties Galore! On Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November.
