

Christmas Week

We have had a lovely end of term two at school this week. Dance Festival

This year, the dance festival is on Thursday, February 13th, and we will be travelling to Cheltenham Town Hall during the day, where we will perform between 3 and 5 pm. If you say yes, then this will confirm that they are part of the dance troupe and that you will be able to collect them from Cheltenham at 5 pm. We currently only have eight children signed up for this. Please let me know ASAP if your child is interested, as ideally, we need 12-15 pupils to make this work.

Academisation

We have received confirmation from the secretary of state that our academy conversion is complete, and she has signed it off, so we will officially join Corinium Education Trust on January 1st, 2025. This is a very exciting announcement and will provide the school with additional support in a variety of areas and allow for strategic planning to continue to ensure that Down Ampney is the BEST it can be every day. It is also a daunting one, not least for me as I have taught for Gloucestershire County Council since 1997 and received my P45 from them this morning! We have done all we can to ensure a smooth transition, but please bear with us as there are likely to be a few bumps and tweaks along the way.

Housekeeping

This is a gentle reminder that gates open at 8:30 am and teachers have planned activities for the children to start as soon as they arrive. The gates close at 8:40 am, and the registers are then taken. If your child arrives after this, then they will need to sign in at the office.

At the end of the day, children need to be collected at 3:15 pm. Please come inside the back gates to collect your children safely. If somebody other than yourself is collecting your child, please email admin@ or leave a voicemail for Mrs Gray. If your child is walking home, then this needs to be agreed with Mrs Gray and informed in writing.

No children may have mobile phones or smartwatches in school. If they need to bring them in as they are walking home alone, they will need to be handed in on arrival.

All children should be in uniform each day with suitable coats for the weather. We ask that you ensure all clothing items are named as we start to go swimming!

We will continue to use the field whenever we can, so feel free to send your child in with wellies and spare trainers/socks.

Drink bottles should only contain water, and snacks should be healthy for break time, ideally fruit.
